Applications are Invited for Preparation of Panel of Emeritus Professors for Haldia Institute of Technology, Haldia, WB, India for Academic, Training & Research Programme.

Haldia Institute of Technology (HIT) is a premier Engineering institute under Indian Centre for Advancement of Research and Education, Haldia (ICARE), a society registered under West Bengal Societies Registration Act, 1961 (Regd. No: S/81826 of 1995-1996). HIT offers 11 B.Tech, 5 M.Tech, MBA and MCA courses. 11 B.Tech courses are Applied Electronics & Instrumentation Engineering, Biotechnology, Chemical Engineering, Civil Engineering, Computer Science & Engineering, Electrical Engineering, Electronics & Communication Engineering, Food Technology, Information Technology, Instrumentation & Control Engineering, and Mechanical Engineering. All courses are AICTE [All India Council for Technical Education] approved. Presently the students strength of HIT is 4404. Total number of faculties at HIT is 250.

Besides HIT, Indian Centre for Advancement of Research and Education, Haldia (ICARE) established 16 Institutions which include ICARE Institute of Medical Sciences and Research and Dr. Bidhan Chandra Roy Hospital, Haldia, Haldia Institute of Dental Sciences and Research, Haldia Law College, Haldia Institute of Maritime Studies and Research, Global Institute of Science and Technology, Vidyasagar Primary Teachers' Training Institute, Institute of Education, Haldia, Haldia Institute of Health Sciences, Haldia Institute of Management, Haldia Institute of Nursing Sciences, Haldia School of Languages, ICARE School of Research and Development, ICARE School of Skill Development, Haldia Institute of Pharmacy, International Institute of Science And Humanities, International Institute of Hospitality etc. There are more than 8000 students on the roll of the Institutes and about 2000 employees working with ICARE.

Institute for Sustainable Development And Research (ISDR) is a registered organization having consultative status with United Nations Economic and Social Council (UN-ECOSOC); United Nations Center for Human Settlement (UNCHS) now UN-Habitat; UN-Environment, United Nations Finance for Development (UN-FfD). ISDR is working for sustainable development. Its areas of activity are education, training, research & development on natural resources such as soil, water, air, agriculture, forest, marine, coastal and river management & their conservation, rural & urban planning, infrastructure development, energy and Green House Gases (GHG) issues, sanitation, industrial development, disaster management, socio-economic development, gender issues, poverty alleviation, environment management, climate change, global environmental changes, etc. The ICARE & ISDR also undertake the research and training programme on sustainable development.

The Haldia Institute of Technology, through ICARE [Indian Centre of Advancement of Research & Education, Haldia] is having Memorandum of Understanding with ISDR and several national and international institution for education, training and research in India and abroad.

The HIT / ISDR is constituting the panel of Emeritus Professors for its programmes on education, training & research in India and Overseas. The selected candidates are expected to contribute to the academic, research and training programme of HIT, ISDR and associated partners in India and abroad through participation in person for minimum 2 weeks and /or distance participation.

The duties of Emeritus Professors are as below:

1. To impart training to the students of HIT and other associate partners.
2. To supervise the research projects undertaken by HIT.
3. To prepare the research and training programme for the HIT and submit the same to various institutes for funding support through HIT or other associated organizations of HIT and complete the same.
4. To organize the workshop, seminar and conference at HIT & other associated organisations on various subjects.
5. To participate in Educational, training and research programme of HIT and other associated organizations and prepare the report / document of the same.
6. During the period of Emeritus Professorship, the applicant is expected to publish research articles in India and overseas journals.
7. The Emeritus professors have to submit the detailed report annually on the activities undertaken under the emeritus professorship within three months after completing the one year of appointment.
8. To contribute for development of academic, training and research programme of HIT and associated partners for minimum 2 weeks per year in India. The Emeritus Professor is expected to devote his time for fulfillment of objects of the programmes for the rest of the period either in his own institute or with the associated organization of HIT or pre-approved institutions by HIT.

The above duties should be performed by the Emeritus Professor as per mutual agreement with HIT, ISDR and other associated organizations.

The HIT will support the local expenses in India for two weeks per year or as decided by HIT. All other expenses should be the responsibility of Emeritus Professor or his institute.

Qualification of Emeritus Professor:

1. The candidate should possess the Ph.D. degree in Engineering & Technology. Other allied subjects related to sustainable development can be considered depending on the requirement and qualification of applicants and activities proposed by the applicants.

2. The candidate must have at least 3 years of academic, training and research experience after obtaining Ph.D.
3. The candidate should provide adequate research publication or completion of research project for assessment of suitability for appointment.
4. The candidate having strong research experience equivalent Ph.D. qualification will be considered for appointment on merit and his contribution to the programmes.
5. The Emeritus Professorship is open for any nationality.

The appointment of Emeritus Professors are purely on honorary basis and non-remunerative. However, the candidate can accept the remuneration received for his research work if provided by other institute for his services rendered under this programme. The selected candidate during their stay, will be provided all the institutional facilities at HIT, Haldia, West Bengal, India or at the associated partners of HIT in India and abroad as per the mutual agreement for completion of academic, training and research programme under this Emeritus Professorship.

Application Guidelines:

The interested candidates for Emeritus Professorship are requested to submit the detailed CV and at least one page outline of activities to be undertaken during the period of Emeritus Professorship by Email given below. The selection panel of HIT will consider the suitability of applicants. The selected candidates will be informed the decision of selection. The selected candidates should submit their willingness with the date of commencement of the Emeritus Professorship. The appointment will be initially for 5 years and may be extended further as per the requirement after assessing the performance of the candidate. The application can be submitted at any time during a year.

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
