**Participation: Total- 3200, Male- 2000, Female- 1200**



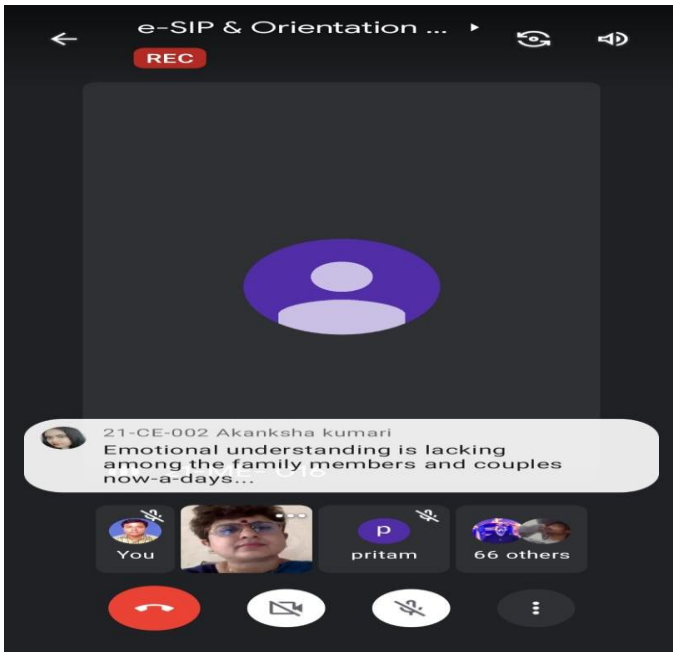

**Participation: Total- 1250, Male- 950, Female- 300**





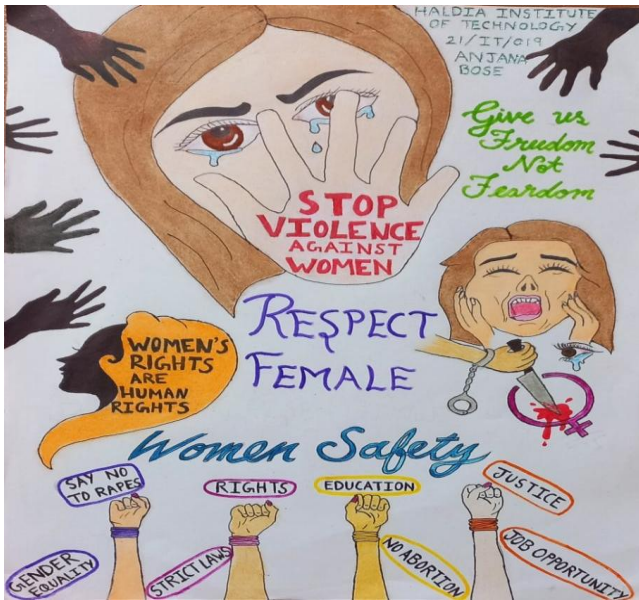

On 14<sup>th</sup> January 2022 on the eve of Surya Namaskar for vitality celebration was organized by NSS officers of Haldia Institute of Technology.

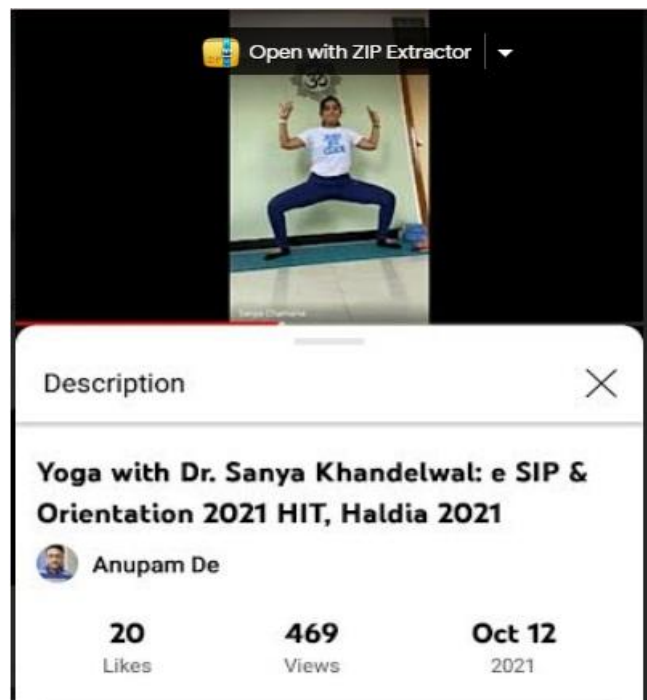

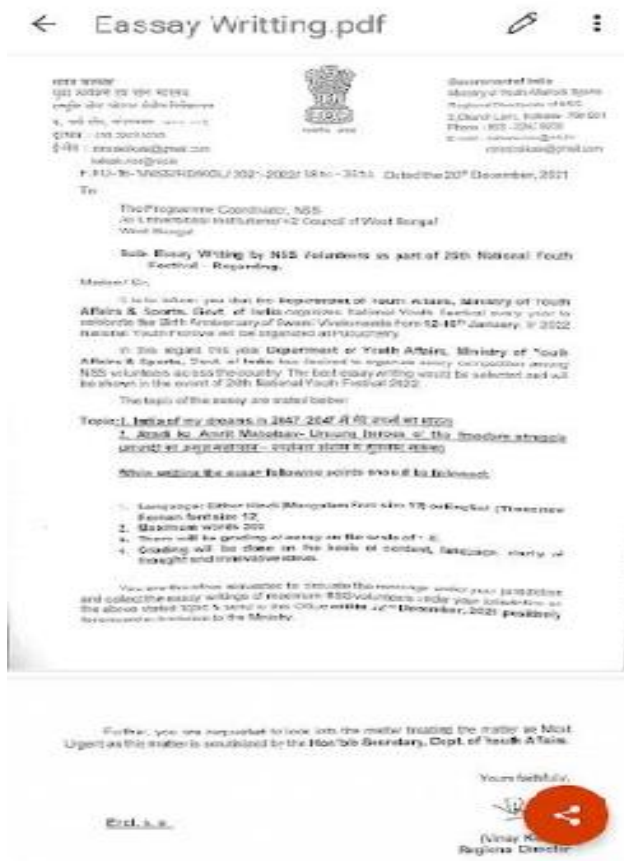

**Participation: Total- 200, Male- 120, Female- 80**



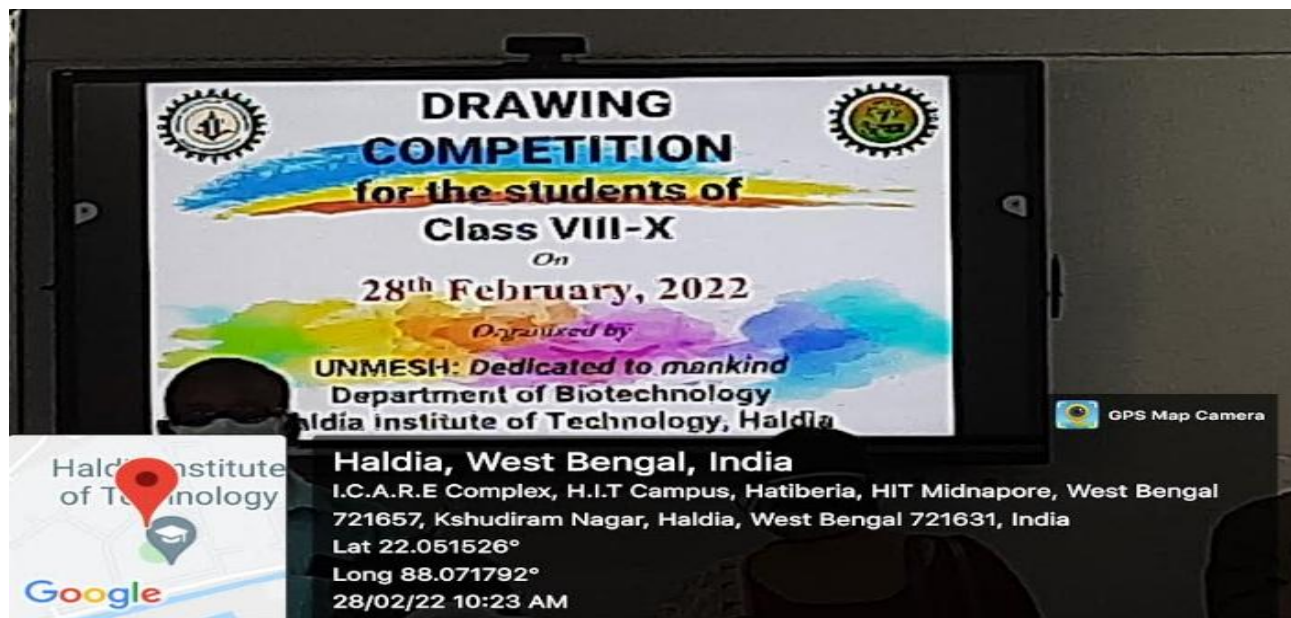
